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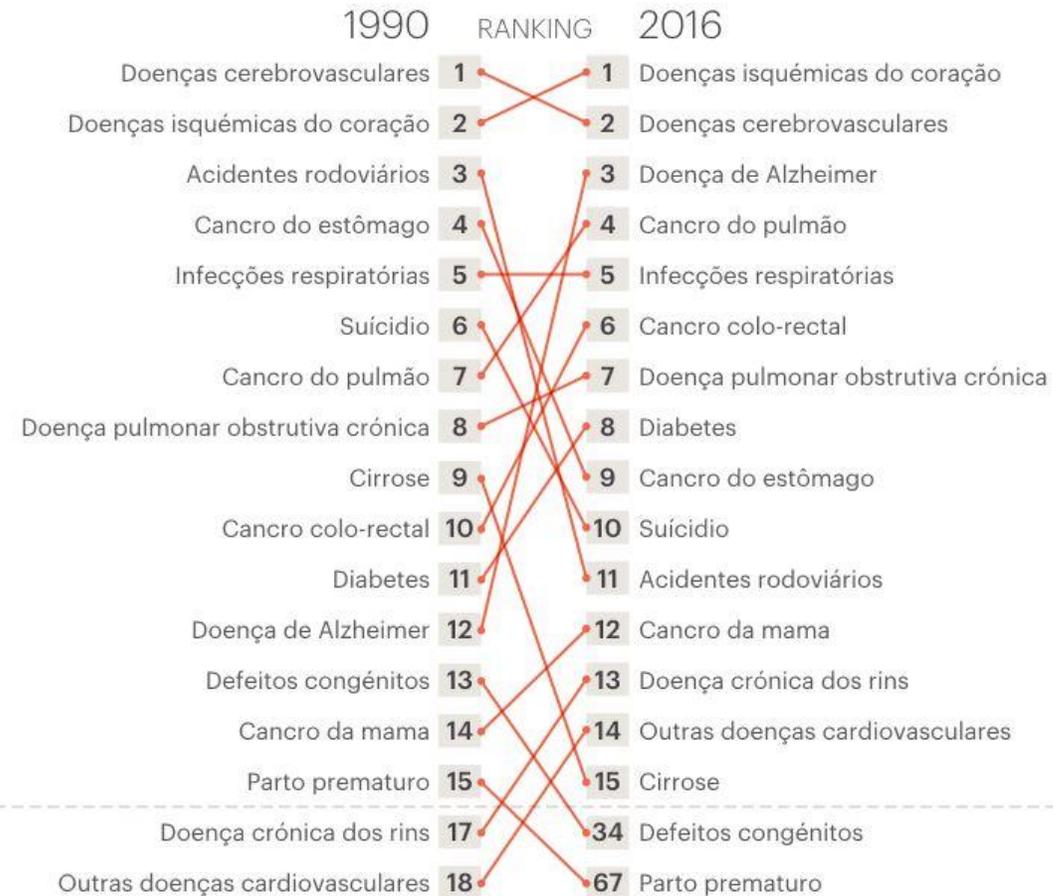
## Aims of the project

- The European CODA-EU project, supported by the Erasmus+ program, aims to provide an innovative learning tool (CODA) to teachers who train medical students, allowing them to improve their knowledge of recommendations and rules set by WHO on certification of causes of death.
- **The second aim of this project is to set up a MOOC dedicated to university trainers and professors wishing to adapt the CODA tool to their educational objectives.**

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## Certification of Causes of Death MOOC

- The MOOC is a free online course designed for a large numbers of participants. It can be accessed by anyone anywhere with an internet connection and doesn't require entry qualifications.
- There are different versions of the MOOC provided in Polish, French, Greek and Portuguese.
- The training materials were jointly prepared by experts from research and academic institutions from Poland, France, Greece and Portugal.
- The MOOC is addressed to medical doctors, medical students and other health professionals for whom the competencies in cause-of-death certification are important.
- The CODA-EU course takes approximately 3 hours to complete (including the final test).
- A certificate is provided for those who complete successfully the final assessment.

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## Certification of Causes of Death MOOC - Portuguese version

### Role of the Portuguese team

- Support to the MOOC learning design process
- Course materials translation and revision (text, PowerPoint, images, graphs).
- Review of the Portuguese system regulation concerning death certificates (summarizing the system architecture and functioning, preparing guidelines on how to fill in the Portuguese death certificate forms).
- Collecting and listing relevant Portuguese official websites, manuals and legislation to be provided as complementary resources for students.
- MOOC Dissemination (establishing a communication strategy, selecting appropriate channels and designing materials).

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## SICO – Sistema de Informação dos Certificados de Óbito

<https://servicos.min-saude.pt/sico>

SICO is the official Portuguese online platform for registering death certificates since 2014.

It allows for the dematerialization of death certificates, speeding up and improving the processing of statistical updates on death causes, as well as the update of the National Health System patient's data Online communication of death certificates to national civil registration services.

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## How does SICO works?

In order to conduct a speedy intervention, SICO cooperates with:

- Police authorities;
- National Medical Emergency Institute (INEM);
- Public Attorney General (MP);
- National Legal Medical and Forensic Sciences Institute, IP (INMCF, IP)
- National Statistics Institute (INE).

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## Case studies (adapted scenarios)

- *Male, 55 years old, with a history of infection by the Hepatitis C Virus with 10 years of evolution. In the last 5 years, he developed chronic hepatitis, progressing to cirrhosis of the liver. He was admitted to the ER tachycardic (130 bpm) and hypotensive (BP 80/50 mmHg). During transport to the ER, he had several episodes of vomiting with blood. Analytically had a haemoglobin of 8.0 g/dL. He died a few hours after hospital admission. The autopsy concluded that the patient died following a hemorrhagic shock because of a rupture of oesophageal varices.*

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## Certification of Causes of Death MOOC - Portuguese version

### First iteration data

- Course start on 17/04/23
- **369** registered participants
- Age range from **19** to **66** years old
- **95** participants completed successfully the final exam
- Only 3 participants failed the final exam
- **40** participants obtain a score of 80% or over (**9** reached a mark of 90% or over)
